7:30 pm Parish Survey Task Update -

Fr. Jeff stated that after getting input from other parishes and a consultant that it is best to keep the survey open-ended. So it will basically address the 5 pillars and ask parishioners to tell about strengths and weaknesses of each. Parishioners will also have the option of having the survey done in an interview style if they prefer not to have to write down all of their thoughts.

The survey is only one piece of the data gathering process. The team will also be conducting interviews with all ministry heads. Tentatively questions such as:

What is your ministry?

What helps you do your ministry well?

What can the parish do to help you do your ministry better?

What as a parish do you see that we so well?

What do you see as a challenge for our parish?

We have weekends in OC, Bethany, a fishing trip, artwork, gift certificates and much more. The committee has reached about \$8,500 of their original \$10,000 goal in sponsorship. We are in good shape. Now we just need to concentrate on selling tickets.

8:10 pm Elections

We discussed ways we can get MORE parishioners involved. We need to "de-mystify" the role of Pastoral Council- let the parish know that we are regular church goers just like them. We could have PC members get up and explain the role of the PC, the time commitment and why we chose to run for PC.

We need reach out during the Ministry Fair. (Lisa is willing to work on a poster for the fair.) Talking to parishioners about running should be ongoing.

8:30 pm Sunday PREP

Ben would like to look into the possibility of offering at least one session for each grade level on Sunday. At the present time grades 2-5 only have class sessions offered Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings. This may also get more parents involved in the PREP program because some may want to be a catechist but are not home from work by 4:45. We may also be able to offer an Adult Faith class at the same time on Sunday so parents can attend while their children are in PREP. He has a meeting scheduled to discuss this with Erin Tate.

Other Business:

Fr. Jeff informed us that the Lower Hall has been renovated. The carpet has been pulled up. It had new paint and new tile.

The Nursery Co-Op has a coordinator, Deb Moran, but as of now **there** has only been one family that has expressed an interest in attending. Hopefully more will sign up as we move out of summer mode into fall.

The former Ladies of St. Andrew used their remaining budget to replace the counter in the kitchen. It is stainless steel and has a larger sink.

The Winter Shelter Coordinator had to step down due to unforeseen family obligations. Fr. Jeff is interviewing 2 others this week. We DO NOT want to have to step out of the program at this time.

Starting this fall we will have **a priest** who have agreed to help Fr. Jeff with weekend masses on an occasional basis. He welcome his presence.

We continue to grow in faith-- We now have 1715 families registered at St. Andrew by the Bay.
