## **...the New Evangelization as a Way of Life**

**"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." – Jesus (Matthew 9:27)**

**What is 3-in-1?** Named in honor of the Trinity, *3-in-1* encourages and equips you to talk with 3 people over the course of 1 year: to share with them your faith and love of Christ, invite them to Mass or a parish/ministry event, or ask them to consider the Catholic Church or come back to it.

**Why?** *To help Catholics make sharing their faith & inviting others a natural part of their lives.*

Many of us know relatives, friends, neighbors, and co-workers who've left the Catholic faith or are searching for meaning in their lives. Unfortunately, many of us are uncomfortable talking about the Faith - maybe because we haven't seen others do it, we fear rejection, or don't know how to respond to questions or concerns about Catholicism.

**How?** Rooted in prayer and personal invitation, *3-in-1* helps us become more comfortable with the idea of reaching out to others, and includes a Kick-Off Event and optional workshops & small group support.

**You don't have to be a theologian to evangelize.** From the beginning of the Church, the laity evangelized along with the apostles (Acts 8:1-4), and for the past 40 years the Church has been urgently calling us to a New Evangelization\*. The idea of *3-in-1* is to "help Catholics help Catholics" overcome our anxieties and embrace the mission of the New Evangelization for ourselves, our families, and our communities. When a person experiences the rewards of sharing the faith and inviting others, it will naturally become a part of his or her life. *3-in-1* is not about a "program" or "numbers," but is a *means to an end*: **Catholics sharing the joy of the Gospel with those they know and love** in their own comfortable style, with their own personality.

Those who sign-up for *3-in-1* commit to three things:

1. Pray for yourself and those you may share with or invite.
2. Invite or share with 3 people over the course of 1 year.
3. Participate in the *3-in-1* Kick-Off on Sunday, Oct 5th.

The **Kick-Off Event** galvanizes the parish to set sail in a new direction with anticipation and adventure that "we're all in this together," led by the Holy Spirit. Speaker, author, and seminary professor Dr. Pat Fosarelli will give a special presentation on simple and practical ways to share our faith, followed by large and small group discussions about hopes, concerns, and apprehensions. Optional future workshops and small group support, if requested, will flow from the Kick-Off to continue to equip and encourage us on our journey.

Kick-Off Event: Sunday, October 5, 12:45-2:45 pm. Optional lunch, 12:30. Child care provided.

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\* The term "New Evangelization" was popularized by St. John Paul II and refers to efforts to reawaken the faith in traditionally Christian parts of the world that were evangelized centuries ago but now stand in need of a "new evangelization." Since Vatican II, the Church has been urgently and repeatedly calling the laity to live *and proclaim* the gospel (good news) of Jesus Christ in the home, workplace, and society (see reverse). St. Andrew's Parish Mission Statement and Vision call us to the same. *3-in-1* challenges and equips us to fulfill this calling.

## Promotion

### 1. Planning

- June. Pre-planning
- July 14. 3-in-1 Planning meeting
- July/August. Finalize the Pre-Evangelization phase and parish-wide promotional materials (lawn signs, suggested scripts for ministry leaders, commitment cards (?), bulletin inserts, etc.)
- Aug 4. Special Pastoral Council Meeting with Parish Staff to align on 3-in-1 and coordinate the Pre-Evangelization (“Quiet” Promotion) Launch in August.

### 2. Pre-Evangelization Phase (“Quiet” Promotion) – 6 Weeks (Aug 4 – Sep 12)

Starts week of August 4. Parish Staff and Pastoral Council (PC) Liaisons personally call on ministry leaders and ministry volunteers (“active and engaged” parishioners):

1. Each Parish Staff member/PC Liaison sets up a time/date to personally introduce the ministry leader to 3-in-1 and the Pre-Evangelization phase, i.e., all the items below, and asks if he/she would like to participate in 3-in-1.
2. Parish Staff/ PC Liaisons ask Ministry Leaders if they would be willing to personally invite their ministry volunteers to also commit to 3-in-1 as a participant. Also ask if the ministry leader would like assistance from the Parish Staff member or PC Liaison to help explain 3-in-1 to their volunteers.
3. Everyone who commits to 3-in-1 during the Pre-Evangelization Phase (Parish Staff, PC Liaisons, Ministry Leaders, and Ministry Volunteers) is asked if he or she would like to take be a “sower” who invites at least 3 fellow parishioners to participate in 3-in-1 during the parish-wide promotion.
4. Parish Staff/PC Liaisons solicit and identify 12 parishioners who would like to share a short (20 second) personal testimony at Mass about how their life of faith would not be what it is today if someone had not taken the initiative and reached out to them. Example:  

"I wouldn't be here today/ I wouldn't have made it through a rough period of my life/ I wouldn't be happily involved in the xxx ministry, if (someone) had not invited me to xxxx."
5. Parish Staff/ PC Liaisons solicit the ideas and feedback of ministry leaders for the rollout of 3-in-1.
