**7:00 Opened with Prayer (“Come Holy Spirit”)**

**7:05 Group Lectio Divina:** Applied the four steps of “divine reading”: read, meditate, pray and contemplate to (**PHIL 4:12-14, 19-20**).

**7:15 Father Jeff Updates:**

- Archdiocese of Baltimore celebrates its 225<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this year. It was established as diocese on November 6, 1789. It is the oldest and therefore premier See in the country. All other dioceses trace their origins back to Baltimore.
- All is good. Staff is good. This was the most hectic weekend (4-5 Oct) in a while. 3-in-1 kickoff was great!
- Please remember Fr. Bill in your prayers. He was Father Jeff’s HS principal. He has entered hospice at peace in his faith. Fr. Jeff will be in Pittsburgh Wednesday-Saturday 10/8-10/11.

**7:20 Sister Parish relationship and upcoming visit**

- Two soon to be identified representatives from our sister parish, San Francisco de Asis in El Salvador, will visit the SABB community, arriving 21 October. They want to immerse themselves in parish activities throughout their visit. A Covenant Celebration of our 24 year affiliation will be celebrated at Mass on Saturday 25 October followed by a Potluck supper in the upper hall.
- Helen Maher provided an update on planned activities. Notes will be published in the bulletin requesting translators and daily drivers during the day and evening. Families will be requested to have our two visitors to their homes for dinner. Anne and Andy Wagner will host them at their house. Helen hopes to have them participate in various ministry meetings and attend PREP. Tours of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception and the Lincoln and MLK Memorials are planned.
- Helen requested the assistance of the PC:
  - After mass the next two weekends to help her sign up people for the 25 Oct potluck dinner to include bringing food and getting a head count. Our Baltimore sister parish (Transfiguration) will be bringing deserts. Several PC members committed to assisting with the sign up.
  - For the assembled Council to meet with our visitors and attend the covenant mass.
  - Liaise with our ministries to talk up participation in the visit, covenant mass, and potluck.
- Update: Since the PC meeting, Helen was informed that the trip of our visitors from San Francisco de Asis has been unfortunately cancelled.

**7:45 Retreat Refection/ Feedback**

- Consensus was that it was a good thing to do and to repeat. It was the right length, spiritually refreshing and a beautiful, peaceful setting.

### **7:55 - 3 in 1 Reflection/ Feedback.**

- Feedback was that roll-out and testimonies were well received. Early discussion with ministries contributed to early signup and the turnout of over 130 parishioners at the kickoff.
- We discussed some of the feedback from the tables we facilitated. The details were turned in and are being collated by Stephany for further action.
- There were handouts made available to the attendees, but the PC missed receiving them during the clean-up. Jim to ask Stephany for some copies to send to those on the council who need them. (Action complete: the handouts were in the Oct 12 bulletin).

### **8:05 Ministry Fair Alternative**

- We have phased out the annual Ministry Fair since the staff is doing so well at getting new parishioners in touch with Ministry Leads.
- To keep the parish aware of the ministries, the ministry leads will be asked by the staff to sign up for Donut Sundays and use those gatherings to set up their table to tell folks about what their ministry does. There was also a discussion about PC liaisons discussing this new method with the ministries. Finally there was concern about how the phase out of the annual Ministry Fair and the phase in of the Donut Sunday approach would be communicated to the ministries. Discuss at next PC meeting.

### **8:15 Parish Honors.**

- Parish Honors were instituted through the good graces of Sister Mary T. to recognize members of the parish who make extraordinary commitments of time and energy to SABB and its ministries. The PC serves as the organization which seeks nominees and presents the awards, three "Loaves and Fishes" and one "Salt of the Earth".
- Susanne told us of seeking nominations from members of the Parish through filling out forms in the back of the church last year and how hard a job it is to select recipients. She did say that last year there was a paucity (less than 15) of forms submitted
- There was an observation that the award winners are probably embarrassed that they've been singled out from among their fellow toilers.
- Others commented that it is a worthwhile exercise to honor those among us and inspires the parish and fellow ministry volunteers.
- We will discuss at next meeting (3 November)
  - Whether we can do a better job at soliciting nominees such as soliciting input directly from the ministries
  - Whether we should change the presentation of the award to include recognition of all of members of the winners' ministries.
  - Explore and discuss additional/alternative ways to show appreciation towards volunteers and leaders of parish ministries.
    - For example: Fr. Jeff announced that the Pastoral Staff is planning to serve ministry leaders/volunteers at a BBQ and it was recalled that there used to be a dinner/dance for volunteers in years past.
    - Other examples mentioned included having recipients/ benefactors of ministries give a short testimony/witness to their thankfulness and how their life has been enriched as a recipient of the work of St. Andrew's ministries ...this is a *real* appreciation (or "reward") of ministry: knowing that others' lives are being affected by our service.

### **8:30 Potential New PC member nominating process**

- Father Jeff suggested that in many parishes there is a move away from the voting process as currently laid out in our PC constitution to a discernment process by which the sitting PC/ Pastor/ Pastoral Staff decide who to invite to become a member of the Council.
- Discussion ensued about:
  - Whether or not to change the process
  - If PC agrees to change the process then which year it will take effect.
  - Whether the PC constitution must be changed in advance
- We will resume the discussion at the next meeting (3 Nov) knowing that at the 1 December meeting we must select the nominating committee to begin the process that leads to the May election.
- Subsequent to the meeting, Fr. Jeff emailed an article on PC discernment to get the conversation started.

- We updated the list to reflect liaisons for the remainder of this PC Term. See attached. Note: AFF is open for a new Liaison.

#### **8:55 Previously deferred agenda items**

- Committee to recommend changes to the constitution to reflect the changed role of the Council?

- Invitations to Standing Committee Chairs to attend and brief status at a PC monthly meeting.
  - Invite Social Committee co-chairs 3 Nov. Susanne invited leaders at the Social Committee meeting and they have accepted. Jim will send formal follow-up invitation via email
  - Invite Justice and Life Committee Chair, Chris Figueras, to the 1 Dec meeting. Jim took the action to send the invitations
- Whether we can/should provide valet parking for disabled/handicapped for mass.
  - Father Jeff ran this up the chain for consideration. Diocese has concerns about legal issues and liability. SABB will not provide such valet parking

  - She attended on 28 September the first meeting of the 2014-2015 Archdiocesan Youth Advisory Council representing our parish. These are monthly meetings. The next one is 19 October
