Parents of 4 year olds: Students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2011.

First Reconciliation and First Eucharist Parents: To begin preparation children must be in 2nd grade and deemed ready by the parents. Parents are the child's first catechist and therefore must be committed to taking an active role in helping to prepare for these sacraments. Such a role requires attending two parent meetings for each of these sacraments and working with your children on a home preparation booklet. To begin preparation for First Eucharist in 2012, your child must have one year of PREP completed and be registered for the year ahead. If you have any doubts or questions about your child's readiness we would love to set up a time to discuss their faith development.

In addition to the PREP program, the Division of Evangelization and Catechesis of the Archdiocese of Baltimore requires that we offer the **Family Life Program**. This is incorporated into the regular schedule. Materials are sent home to parents. Please complete the attached Permission slip and return with completed registration form.

* Grade 10 students will have a total of four additional weeknight sessions between January and April as they prepare for Confirmation.

To be eligible for Confirmation in 2012, the student must be in Grade 10 or older, was registered and participated in a Religious Education program during the past year, and is registered in class for the 2011-12 year. This is an Archdiocesan regulation.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIA-R)

For children Grade 3 and above (& their families) who are: not baptized, or not baptized Catholic, or baptized Catholic but with little or no religious education. This is a special two-year process initiated by the Archdiocese. Parents who have children in this group will be contacted with further information.

CLASSES ARE FILLED ON A FIRST-COME BASIS. DO NOT DELAY SENDING IN YOUR FORM. REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE TAKEN OVER THE PHONE. Being in a carpool does not assure you of a place if your form is not completed and returned.



By registering my child(ren) in the Faith Formation Program, I understand that:

- ❖ My family must be registered at St. Andrew by the Bay parish.
- ❖ Completion of this form does NOT register my child for Sacramental Preparation (1st Communion, Reconciliation or Confirmation. This sacramental information will be available at a later date.)
- ❖ As an integral part of our faith formation curriculum, we will be teaching “Catechesis for Family Life” (grades 1-5) and “Created to Love” (grades 6-12). These age-appropriate programs about Christian living, chastity, character formation, and safe environment training promotes communication between you and your child. You are encouraged to review the program materials that the teacher/catechist will be using in the classroom, as well as the materials you will receive for home discussion. After examining the program, if you have any questions or concerns about your child participating in this program, please contact **Erin Tate (grades 1-5) or Lisa Franceschini (grades 6-12)** at 410-974-4366.
- ❖ Classes begin promptly at the designated time and attendance is required for the entire length of class in order to be credited with attendance.
- ❖ Children must be picked up inside the church hall at dismissal time. Children are not allowed to leave the hall without an adult.
- ❖ Parents/guardians of participants are advised that photographs or videotape of participants may be used in publications, websites or other materials produced from time to time by the Division of Youth and Young Adult Ministry or the Archdiocese of Baltimore. (Participants would not be identified, however, without specific written consent.) Parents/guardians who do not wish their child(ren) to be photographed or filmed should so notify the Division in writing. Please note that the Division has no control over the use of photographs or film taken by media that may be covering the event in which your child(ren) participates.
