Minutes of the Pastoral Council Meeting Tuesday, November 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Gallagher at 7:05 PM.
The attendees were Susan Baum, Father Martin Burnham, Michelle Cassidy, Chris Cook, Tim Feist, Chris Figueras, Tom Gallagher, Chuck Kennedy, Glenn McKnab and Ben Mullaly.

The opening prayer, Lectio Divina Luke 17:11-19 was led by Glenn McKnab.

Maurice "Mo" Hickey presented the report from the Finance Committee. The Finance committee is looking at coordinating all parish fundraising.

Father Martin stated that items of purely information will be placed in the agenda but not necessarily discussed at the meeting. He did note that the mass and dedication of the new tabernacle at the Feast of St. Andrew will take place at 7 PM (vice 7:30 PM). Driveway construction is on-going. Parking lot repaving and restriping has not been budgeted. Refurbishment and restoration of the Hall is approved, but per the Archdiocese, no additions can be made. Father Martin will talk with the Finance Committee regarding the way ahead. Staff search for youth minister is still continuing. Parent volunteers have committed to running the program through June if necessary. The position of office assistant is still vacant.

Time & Talent survey is the weekend of 6-7 November. Parish Council members should work with their assigned committees to encourage recommitment and get energy going.

Tom led a discussion on the Pastoral Council Role and retreat. Father Martin believes we should work with the parishioners to strengthen their relationship with Christ. Chris Figueras discussed the Parish Assessment and Renewal Program that was implemented in her former parish to build better communication between parish committees.

Meeting adjourned at 9 PM.
